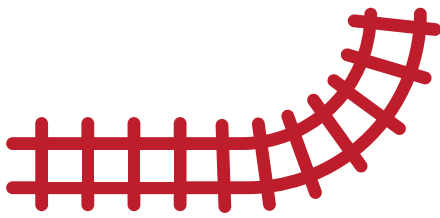


Independant Travelling



Travelling by bus checklist:

- ★ Wait at the bus stop
- ★ Look out for the correct bus, the bus number or name on front
- ★ Stay on the footpath
- ★ When the bus is coming hold out your arm to let the driver know to stop
- ★ Wait until the bus stops (if you are not sure if this is the correct bus can you ask the driver)
- ★ Have your smartpass or money ready before the bus arrives
- ★ Get on the bus and ask for your ticket if paying cash
- ★ Use your smartpass by putting it in the machine
- ★ Wait to get your ticket
- ★ Find a seat (sit near the front near the driver, if it is a double decker, sit downstairs)
- ★ Know when you are near the stop and ring the bell once
- ★ When the bus has stopped stand up and walk to the front of the bus
- ★ When you get off the bus let the bus drive off before you cross the road
- ★ Remember to use the green cross code



Travelling by train checklist:

- ★ Find out what time the train will arrive at the station and what platform number
- ★ Make sure the train will be stopping where you want to get off
- ★ Find out what train will get you home
- ★ Get your train ticket at the ticket desk before you get on the train
- ★ Can you use your money or half fare concessionary pass and money
- ★ Always stand back from the edge, behind the yellow line
- ★ Listen carefully for announcements, these might be about delays or changes
- ★ If you are not sure about things ask a member of staff on the platform for help
- ★ When you are on the train keep your ticket where you can get it easily, the conductor may want to see it

Don't worry if there is no ticket desk at your station, you will be able to buy your ticket on the train from the conductor.
